INFANT PROGRAM

Our infant program serves children between six weeks and 24 months. Your baby's daily home routine is respected as fully as possible by our teachers. All areas of development are closely observed so we can address the individual needs of each child.

Lakeview provides diapers and wipes and meets all your child's nutritional needs while in our care. Lakeview encourages breastfeeding and works with parents to address comfort and privacy.

- Safe, clean classrooms
- NAEYC-recommended group size and ratio
- Infants interacting with caregivers and children through songs, stories and play
- Teachers helping infants express their needs verbally, and non-verbally through sign language

- Outdoor activities on specially designed infant play area
- Parents and teachers communicating and working together
